

Ibrox Stadium is accessible to disabled visitors on non-match days, including for stadium tours and other events. Rangers Football Club is committed to ensuring that all guests, regardless of mobility or sensory needs, can enjoy their visit comfortably.

Wheelchair Access: The stadium offers multiple wheelchair-accessible platforms across all stands. Each platform is equipped with lift access, and the stadium features lowered kiosks and accessible toilets to accommodate wheelchair users.

Accessible Toilets and Lifts: Accessible toilets and lifts are available throughout the stadium and Edmiston House, ensuring ease of movement for all visitors.

Step-Free Routes and Drop-Off Points: The stadium provides step-free routes and designated drop-off points to facilitate entry and exit for those with mobility challenges.

Accessible Parking: Accessible parking is available at the stadium, situated around 200 meters from the entrance.
